

**CITY COUNCIL MEETING
MARCH 14, 2022**

The Greenville City Council convened in the Council Chamber of City Hall on Monday, March 14, 2022, at 5:30 p.m. for a regular Council meeting. Mayor Dexter McLendon called the meeting to order. City Clerk - Treasurer Dee call the roll and recorded the following members present: Mayor McLendon, Councilmembers Bryan Reynolds, Ed Sims, Joseph West, Jae'Ques Brown, and Boris Thigpen. Mayor McLendon led those attending in the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag. Councilmember Brown delivered the invocation.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Mayor McLendon advised each councilmember had received for review a copy of the proposed minutes for the Regular Council Meeting held on February 28, 2022. He asked if there were any additions, deletions or amendments to the minutes as presented.
