The Mac Crenshaw Memorial Airport, operated by the City of Greenville, Greenville, Alabama, hereby publishes a proposed overall goal for its Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program for FY 2021-2023 for the City of Greenville. The proposed overall goal is 9.90% for all FAA-AIP funded projects. The proposed goal for FY 2021 is 9.61% for all FAA-AIP funded projects, and the proposed goal for FY 2023 for all FAA-AIP funded projects is 10.18%. The FY 2022 project did not require development of a DBE goal. The methodology used in developing this goal is available for inspection at the Office of the City Clerk-Treasurer, City of Greenville, Alabama, Ms. Dee H.
